Prepare For a Successful

Digital Media Package

What media will I receive from my presentation?

- You will receive a digital media package including both professional photos and a professionally recorded video/audio of your presentation.

When can I expect to receive my photos?

- You will receive your social media-ready images within 24 hours after your presentation. This will include a few preview photos from your presentation.
- We encourage you to share your photos while still at the event. This is a great way to get the most out of your media package while on site.
- You will receive an additional photo package with more photos within 10-12 weeks.

When can I expect to receive the video of my presentation?

- You will receive your professionally recorded video within 10-12 weeks after the event.
- We will also share this video to our Compass AI platform to help get your presentation in front of thousands of global Medtech leaders. (Please notify us if you prefer to keep this video private).

How can I maximize the distribution with my media package from LSI Europe '26?

- We encourage you to share your photos to LinkedIn and other social media platforms both during and after the event.
- Be sure to tag @LSI and @LSI Europe, and use #LSIEurope26 so our team can engage and help amplify the post.
- After receiving your video we recommend using this in your marketing and distribution efforts.

When are my slides due? How do I submit them? What's the slide format?

- Please send an electronic copy of your presentation in PowerPoint to **lsievents@ls-intel.com** by **Monday, September 14, 2026**.
- Please label your presentation in the following manner:
 - **Time - Your Company Name - Room - Day**
 - Example: 9.00am-YourCompanyName - Library A - Day 1
- Use 16:9 (widescreen) aspect ratio.
- You will not use your computer for your presentation. We preload your presentation onto our AV staff's equipment and use their systems.
- Please embed any video files you may have. AV laptops will not have internet access for hyperlinks.
- To avoid any font errors during your presentation, please use Microsoft PowerPoint stock fonts. Any special fonts may not successfully transfer over to the AV team's computers.
- Recommended font size: 36 for key take aways / 32-34 for general info / 12 (or smaller) for any fine print

How long is my presentation?

- After being introduced to the stage by a moderator, you will have a full 9 minutes to deliver your presentation.
- Please rehearse your presentation and be prepared to end at or before the 9 minute mark.

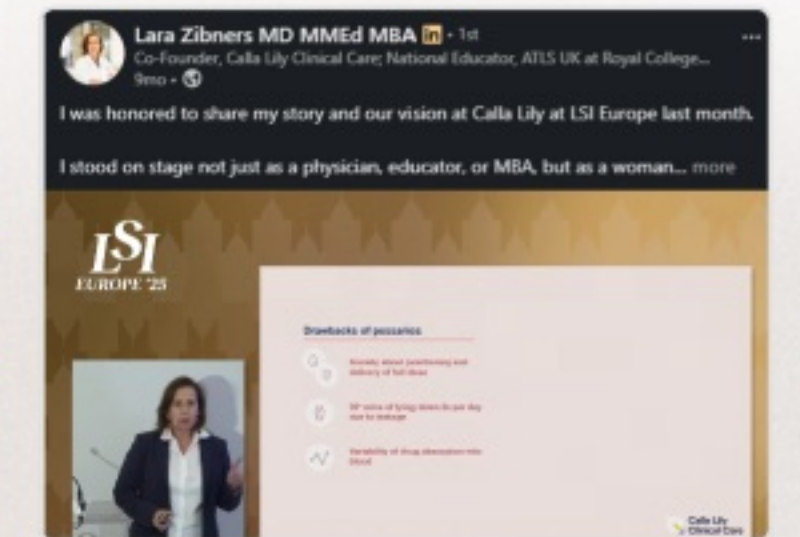
How many slides should my presentation have?

- There is no "correct" number of slides to include in your presentation.
- Typically, the audience is interested in hearing about your company's current status, management team overview, stage of development, technology details & differentiation, target markets, current funding situation and needs, etc.
- Keep in mind that the presentation needs to be 9 minutes or less. (30 seconds per slide is 18 slides, 1 minute per slide is 9 slides, etc.)

How will I change slides when I'm on stage?

- While presenting you will have a clicker to control your slides as well as a display screen facing the stage for you to view.
